

Daily Staff Schedule- counselor

Wake Up Bell 7:30AM

Dress for Morning Celebration and Breakfast

Breakfast 8:00-9:00AM

Located at the Dining Hall

Morning Celebration 9:00-9:30

Chapel

Cabin Clean Up 9:30-10:00AM

Make sure your campers clean their spaces, and have what they need for their activities

Activity Choice #1 10:00-11:00

Campers will gather, and then depart to their first activity they chose. Staff will either have this time off, or will be leading an activity.

Transition Time 11:00-11:15AM

Campers gather up to go to their next activity.

Choice #2 11:15-12:15PM

Campers will gather, and then depart to their second activity they chose. Staff will either have this time off, or will be leading an activity.

Lunch 12:30-1:30PM

Toss Ins (any camper who received a package or 3 letters can choose to get tossed into the lake after lunch, or they can elect a staff member to go in for them)

Toes Up 1:30-2:30PM

This is also known as rest hour. Counselors take their campers back to their cabins for rest hour, where campers can nap, read, journal, or do something quietly. Counselors will often start to prepare their campers for waterfront time as well.

Waterfront 2:30-4:30 PM

Counselors will drop off their campers at the Waterfront for swim time and camp store time. Campers will stay at the waterfront under the supervision of lifeguards and other staff members. Staff members often has this time off, unless they are a lifeguard.

Camper Cleanup 4:30-5:00PM

Counselors will pick up their campers at the Waterfront and take them to cleanup. Shower times are on a rotating schedule, and campers will either shower that day, or the next.

Cabin Connections 5:00-6:00PM

Counselors will plan a cabin connection with their cabin during this time, as a way to bond with the members of their cabin. Cabins will have an opportunity to go tubing during this time, one day a week.

Dinner 6:00-7:00PM

Located at the dining hall.

Evening Reflections 7:00-7:30PM

Chapel

Camp Game 7:30-8:30PM

Please make sure campers have closed toed shoes, depending on the game.

Campfire 8:30-9:30PM

Leadership staff and counselors will work together to plan a campfire with songs and skits. Staff participation is an expectation.

Tuck-Ins/program meeting 9:30-10:00PM

Counselors will meet at the end of the night to have a debrief, and take care of personal needs before the night. Campers will be getting ready for bedtime with an assigned staff member (often a kitchen staff member or program staff member).

Reflections/ Goodnight 10:00PM

Counselors will have a reflection time with their campers about their day, and then go to sleep for the night.

Roving 10:00PM-11:00PM

Leadership staff will rove camp during the night to make sure staff and campers have gone to bed, as well as ensuring lights are turned off.
